**Who Can Enter:** Any new student with a 3.0 grade point average planning to attend the School of Art+Design (SA+D) at Montgomery College in the fall 2010 semester is eligible to enter the Sophie Danish Scholarship Competition. No application fee is required.

### Criteria:

- Ten works, including five to eight drawings from observation, each clearly labeled with your name, accompanied by a written list of all work submitted. Actual artwork is preferred, but 35mm slides/CD-ROM will also be considered.
- A completed School of Art + Design at Montgomery College application form (download one online, or call to request a copy).
- A letter of recommendation (from your art teacher preferred).
- A copy of your high school or college transcript.

**Award and Notification:** A full scholarship will be awarded to one student on the basis of artistic merit of both the portfolio review and drawing test by the SA+D faculty committee and director. Notification of the scholarship competition results will be mailed by August 2, 2010, to all participants. The scholarship recipient will be required to complete the Montgomery College Foundation application and write a note of gratitude to the scholarship sponsor.
